

Library Flex Space During Worship

Children are always welcome in the sanctuary and Sunday morning worship is intended to be a family experience. However, we appreciate that some parents might need support during worship with wiggly little ones. Therefore, we have created a relaxed space in the first-floor library for use during worship. This space is outfitted with toys, crayons/paper, books, puzzles, and more. The worship service is live streamed in the library so you will not miss any part of the service. This space is open to anyone who finds they would be more comfortable using this alternate room.

Badger Prairie Needs Network-Last Build Warehouse Addition

Needs of the community require BPNN to expand one more time. Additional warehouse space, workspace for the leadership team, bigger offices for Joining Forces for Families and space for new programs to tackle the challenges of poverty are needed. Volunteers face cramped quarters to do their work and provide services for the clients. The addition will add 12,000 square feet on two floors along with a loading dock. More than 75% of the \$3.4 million goal has already been secured. All donations of \$100 or more will be recognized in the new addition. Salem's mission committee will donate \$100 of their budgeted funds towards this campaign. Salem has played a significant role in the history of BPNN and the committee feels it is important for Salem to contribute and be recognized. During the month of May do your part to fight poverty and end hunger. The committee encourages members of the congregation to donate towards the last build, every contribution is important.
